

**HELPFUL HINTS  
FOR THE TOWN OF EVANS  
Program start date: January 1, 2010**

**SOLID WASTE COLLECTION — BEGINS PROMPTLY @ 7:00 AM**

- Place material within 5 feet of the curb no later than 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.
- 8 Garbage item limit, (Bulk items included in item count)
- A maximum of 60 lbs. is allowable for each container or bag.
- Units containing CFC's must have a sticker verifying proper removal of gases or will not be picked up.
- Grass must be properly bagged or in containers not exceeding the 60 lbs. weight limit.
- Brush and/or branches must be securely bundled in lengths less than 4 feet with diameters of 2 inches or less and within the weight limit (60 lbs.)
- Christmas trees will be collected during and after the Holiday Season.
- Materials left behind by private contractors **will not** be collected.

**RECYCLING COLLECTION**

- Acceptable materials (see reverse side) are to be placed in the recycling containers provided by the Town within 5 feet of the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day.

**HOLIDAY SCHEDULE**







- New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.

# TOWN OF EVANS GUIDE TO RECYCLING

MATERIALS	WHAT TO PLACE IN RECYCLING BOX	WHAT TO PLACE IN TRASH
<p><b>NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES &amp; CATALOGS</b></p>  <p>Anything that comes with your regular newspapers. Magazines delivered to your home or purchased at a newsstand. All Catalogs, phone books, and junk mail.</p>	<p>Place in recycling box loose, or put next to recycling bin in paper bags. Put Junk mail and writing paper in paper bags. <b>DO NOT USE STRING OR PLASTIC BAGS.</b></p>	<p><b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Napkins, tissue paper, paper towels, wax paper, wrapping paper. <b>ANY FOOD SOILED PAPER</b></p>
<p><b>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</b></p>  <p>Recycle all brown corrugated cardboard. Brown paper bags. Box board (shoe boxes, gift boxes, cereal boxes)</p>	<p>Remove all tape, staples and strapping. Break down all boxes in 3 feet x 3 feet sections. Small pieces in brown bags.</p>	<p><b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Waxed corrugated, cardboard lined with foam, pizza boxes, any <b>fridge/freezer boxboard</b>, and <b>pop/beer boxboard</b>.</p>
<p><b>GLASS BOTTLES</b></p>  <p>All clear, green and brown food and beverage containers.</p>	<p>Wash containers. Remove lids and caps. Labels <b>DO NOT</b> have to be removed. Put all containers &amp; <b>METAL</b> lids and caps in recycling box.</p>	<p><b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Ceramic bottles and other ceramic items, flower pots, crystal, lightbulbs, mirror &amp; window glass, heat resistant ovenware, hypodermic syringes, eyeglasses.</p>
<p><b>METAL CANS</b></p>  <p>All metal food &amp; beverage containers (cans). Metal lids, closure caps, aluminum pie tins</p>	<p>Wash Containers. Remove lids &amp; caps. Labels <b>DO NOT</b> have to be removed.</p>	<p><b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Propane cylinders, silverware, metal/cardboard containers (frozen juice or motor oil), small appliances, metal cookware, tin foil, or hypodermic needles. <b>DO NOT INCLUDE ANY TYPE OF BATTERY.</b></p>
<p><b>PLASTIC</b></p>  <p>Plastic food, soap &amp; beverage containers with threaded caps.  (Screw on lids)</p>	<p>Wash containers Only small necked containers NO wide mouth containers such as yogurt and cottage cheese even if they are labeled with the recycling symbol. <b>NO</b> styrofoam. <b>NO</b> deli-containers. <b>NO</b> microwave containers.</p>	<p><b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Anti-freeze or motor oil containers, furniture, plates, plastic bags, tableware, medicine bottles, plexiglass, fast food containers, snack bags, yogurt &amp; cottage cheese containers and Tupperware® (because of residue).</p>
<p><b>MILK CARTONS JUICE CARTONS DRINK BOXES</b></p>  <p>Gable top beverages. Containers including those with plastic spouts. Remove lids</p>	<p>Rinse and empty Place in recycling bin with other containers. Do not mix cartons with newspaper or corrugated cardboard.</p>	<p><b>ITEMS NOT RECYCLABLE</b> Straws from drink boxes Frozen food containers Waxed paper or drink pouches</p>
