**RESOLUTION 2018 #348 Sturgeon Point Marina Grant**

WHEREAS, the Town of Evans desires to provide access to a safe and attractive public waterfront to support recreational boating and tourism; and

WHEREAS, the Town operates the Sturgeon Point Marina, which supports a strong recreational boating and fishing industry, but needs significant repairs to sustain operation and protect public health, welfare and safety; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers prepared a study that details the critical need for immediate repair to the marina breakwall to ensure its structural integrity and that the potential failure of this breakwall could result in the loss of marina operations; and

WHEREAS, loss of the use and operation of Sturgeon Point Marina would have devastating impacts on regional boating and fishing industries, adversely affect local tourism and eliminate essential access to Lake Erie waters for State and Federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to apply for financial assistance through the filing of a Consolidated Funding Application through the NYS Local Waterfront Revitalization Program to secure the resources needed to undertake necessary repairs at Sturgeon Point Marina; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board commits to providing the required local matching funds to insure the timely implementation of this project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Evans Town Board authorizes the submittal of an application for New York State Local Waterfront Revitalization Program funding in an amount
