**Garbage/Refuse Collection**

**Helpful hints:**

**FOR COLLECTION:** Place garbage, recyclables and bulky items at the roadside within 5 ft. of the road, before 7:00 a.m. on your pick-up day, but not sooner than 6:00 p.m. of the previous day. All streets are covered only once.

**GARBAGE:** Eight (8) items shall be the maximum total number of garbage bags or cans including, but are not limited to: Furniture, mattresses & box springs, carpets, and appliances, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers or any other appliances still containing FREON/CFC gas. Due to a federal mandate, FREON/CFC gases must be removed by a certified service technician & property tagged before disposal.

**SIZE LIMIT:** All solid waste should be placed in bags or containers not exceeding 30 gallons capacity and/or 50 pounds in weight.

**EXCLUSIONS:** No hazardous waste or animal feces.

**HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. If your collection day is on or follows any of these holidays during the week, then collection will be one day later. If the holiday falls during a weekend, collection will be on normal schedule. **Christmas trees**, please watch penny saver for drop off

**TIRES:** To dispose of tires, call the Parks Department at 549-0970 for details.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS:** Includes oil base paints, solvents, pesticides, lead acid batteries, fluorescent lights, fever thermometers, mercury switches & propane tanks. **ERIE COUNTY DROP-OFF DAYS.** Watch local media & penny saver for dates, sites & instructions.

**PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR. RECYCLING BIN IS VISIBLE FOR THE COLLECTOR.**

Securely tie bundles of brush and building materials in lengths no longer than 4 feet.

Your recyclables may be co-mingled. Newspaper must be secured and corrugated cardboard collapsed into flat pieces. Newspaper in TOPS plastic bags will not be picked up. TOPS plastic bags are not recyclable.
