

ATTENTION EVANS RESIDENTS: REVISIONS IN REFUSE/RECYCLE PROCEDURES

As of January 1, 2010 a new garbage/recycle contract will be in effect for residents of the Town of Evans. As a result of a low bidding – Allied Waste Services will collect refuse and recyclables.

CLIP AND SAVE

Your refuse/recyclables will continue to be collected on the day you are currently serviced.

When one of the six major holidays – New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, or Christmas occurs on a weekday – all service in the town will be provided one day later.

All items will be collected on the day that is assigned to a particular area of the town. These items include garbage, recyclables, and/or large bulky items.

Calling to have a large item picked up is not necessary. However, if there is something unusual, Allied Waste Services personnel could be called with advance notice of large items – by calling 614-3333 or 1-800-283-4220.

A total of 8 items will be collected. Residents can expect their refuse to be collected no earlier than 7:00 A.M. and concluded by 6:00 P.M.

Recyclables must be separated from refuse and placed in the appropriate bin. The recyclables may be co-mingled. Newspapers should be secured (in a paper bag) to prevent the wind distribution. Corrugated cardboard must be collapsed into flat pieces.

Recycle bins will be collected during the same hours (also same day), but are not considered in the 8-item count. At this time replacement bins will continue to be available at the Supervisor's office.

Yard waste (brush) should be bundled and cut in lengths of four feet or less.

Tires and hazardous materials will not be collected. You may call the Parks Department (549-0970) once a year for tire pick up -maximum four tires, off the rims.

SIZE LIMIT: All solid waste should be placed in bags or containers not exceeding 50 gallons capacity and/or 50 pounds in weight.

ITEM LIMIT: On a weekly basis, in addition to recyclable items, a limit of eight (8) items will be taken.

BULKY WASTE – Will be collected with solid wastes and will be included with the 8 item limit per week. Refrigerators/freezers must be tagged by a licensed refrigeration specialist stating FREON FREE.
