RESOLUTION 2010-121 Oppose Siting of Wind Towers Offshore in Lake Erie's Eastern Basin

Councilman Cooper moved and Supervisor Pordum seconded,

RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE NEW YORK POWER AUTHORITY PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE INCENTIVES FOR THE SITING OF WIND TOWERS (GREAT LAKES OFFSHORE WIND PROJECT) IN LAKE ERIE'S EASTERN BASIN

WHEREAS, The New York Power Authority (NYPA) has issued a Request for Proposals for the construction, siting and operation of wind turbine facilities in Lake Erie and/or Lake Ontario's Eastern Basin; and

WHEREAS, the proposed wind turbine project is to be between 120 and 500 megawatts and be located in State waters, and will also include a landing site(s) and on-land transmission line(s) to a NYISO Transmission System interconnection; and

WHEREAS, NYPA has provided an incentive for said projects by committing to purchase the electricity it generates regardless of cost either through a long term purchase power agreement or through the outright purchase of the generating facility once it is operational; and

WHEREAS, said project would be the first fresh-water, off-shore based wind project in the nation; and

WHEREAS, NYPA's maps of potential sites for said turbines include significant portions of the Town of Evans' scenic and economically and environmentally sensitive Lake Erie shoreline; and

WHEREAS, said project will have a negative impact on many Town of Evans landowners, homeowners, and businesses, including potential effects on real estate values, scenic vistas, quality of life, and the tourism, hospitality and recreation industry; and

WHEREAS, the areas in Lake Erie that are proposed for these turbines are some of the best sport fishing grounds in the lake and it is highly likely that there will be vast restrictions on the use of the waters surrounding the proposed turbines; and

WHEREAS, in the proposed tower areas of Lakes Erie and Ontario numerous submerged cultural resources exist for which New York State is responsible to protect and provide public access under the Abandoned Shipwreck Act of 1987, and construction of wind towers will likely limit access to these historic resources for research and recreational purposes, and may pose a threat of destruction of these resources; and

WHEREAS, no financial benefit will accrue to any municipality including the Town of Evans, because the facilities will be exempt from local and real property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the project will require the construction of transmission facilities which would result in a negative economic impact on tourism destinations due to the effect on scenic vistas, and depending on their locations, could also negatively affect the farming community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Evans Town Board hereby acknowledges, approves, and accepts this resolution, and be it

RESOLVED, that the Town of Evans Town Board encourages and welcomes job-creating economic development projects, business expansions, and new businesses in the township that are consistent with our communities' values, enhance quality of life, and present no harm to the unique characteristics of this township that we all cherish, however; we feel this project is inconsistent with our community goals and so we strongly oppose the New York Power Authority plan for the placement of wind turbines in the East Basin of Lake Erie.
